About Us

Fearless Kitty Rescue was founded in 2012 on the belief that all cats and kittens deserve a chance to be Fearless. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit no-kill cat rescue in metropolitan Phoenix and the surrounding areas. We are dedicated to rescuing cats left homeless for whatever reason – cats in municipal shelters, where they are at high risk of euthanasia due to animal overpopulation, abandoned and homeless strays, cats surrendered by their owners because of difficult circumstances, and those in danger of abuse or neglect.

Message from Leadership

To all our Fearless Kitty Rescue supporters:

Your contributions and efforts have been instrumental in making 2024 a remarkable year for Fearless Kitty Rescue. We started 2024 raising funds to help pay off our mortgage. A very special donor saw our request and gave us the funds to eliminate our mortgage in November 2024. What a fantastic gift it was to own our building free and clear! With no mortgage payments, we can now use the additional funds to save more cats and kittens. This gift is truly a blessing we are thankful for every day.

Our financial results for 2024 reflect this large donation and have enabled us to continue introducing new programs and goals. The 2024 results are even stronger than 2023 with over \$1,194,000 in revenue and support. We are currently upgrading our building as old items wear out by replacing old air conditioners with a new state-of-the-art mini-split system as well as replacing the underlayment on our tile roof. Now, even in the middle of July, we have the coolest cats in town. Even with these additional expenses we still managed to keep our overhead to 9 cents for each dollar spent! Our balance sheet became even stronger with the payoff of our mortgage.



2024 saw even more major milestones. We achieved our 3,000th intake and our 3,000th adoption! Fearless also successfully launched our Silver Whiskers program for senior cats in February, and we were honored to be named the *Fountain Hills Chamber of Commerce Nonprofit of the Year*.

Reflecting on 2024 as strong as it was, we have not sat on our laurels. We started 2025 by saving over 20 cats from the California wildfires. In addition, we are

working on introducing some new and important programs in 2025, including how to achieve the growth we want to see for your rescue. Fearless will always continue to grow and seek more ways to help our community and save the lives of more and more cats.

Please join us as we continue our successes in 2025 and find loving permanent homes for every cat and kitten passing through our doors.

As we reflect on the past year, we are filled with gratitude for the incredible progress we have made in our mission to rescue and rehome cats in need. Thanks to your unwavering support and dedication, we have been able to make a meaningful impact in the lives of hundreds of homeless cats.

In 2024, Fearless Kitty rescued over 400 cats, giving them a loving safe place while they waited for their new families. We are pleased to say that 374 of those cats found new homes last year. These numbers are not just statistics; they represent lives saved and families transformed by the power of compassion.

Our work goes beyond simply finding homes for cats. Peritonitis is a common and aberrant immune response in cats to infection with feline coronavirus. Until very recently FIP was always fatal. But important, and long-running research, has made significant and curative progress. FIP is now treatable and curable.



Cason is doing well! He is an amazing cat! After many weeks in the Fearless Kitty medical unit, and wonderful care from his foster family, Cason is home. His forever family shared this about Cason: "He's a curious boy and loves to help in the kitchen, especially if you're not looking!"

Silver Whiskers



This year our Silver Whiskers Program continued to give much needed attention to older cats like Bastet. We're not sure what life has dealt her, but when she was



rescued from the streets it was clear that she wanted a forever home. At Fearless Kitty Rescue, we are dedicated to finding loving homes for all cats, including those in their golden years. That's why we launched the Silver Whiskers Program focusing on senior cats, aged seven and above, who are often overlooked in shelters and rescues. By providing special attention to health checkups, vaccinations, and adoption opportunities, we are helping older felines find a place to rest and make all the toe biscuits they can muster for the rest of their lives. And the good news is....*Bastet found her forever home!*

Volunteers

Fearless Kitty Rescue relies heavily on very dedicated volunteers to accomplish our goals and succeed in our efforts. During 2024, our volunteers provided over 24,449 hours of help to allow us to achieve our goals. This amounts to nearly 12 full-time employees throughout the year. This is a huge success story, especially when we consider the large number of cats and kittens in our care. Volunteers provide socialization, foster care, feeding, cleaning, and event support. We simply could not provide the cat and kitten care we do without our wonderful volunteer team!



Grants

Successful grant writing efforts can be a mainstay for non-profit organizations like Fearless Kitty Rescue. During 2024, we received several generous grants which helped us acquire much needed medical supplies, spay neuter services, vaccinations, and much needed food and cleaning supplies. A total of \$22,500 was received from various grants. The work continues to ensure that more kittens and cats can find loving homes.

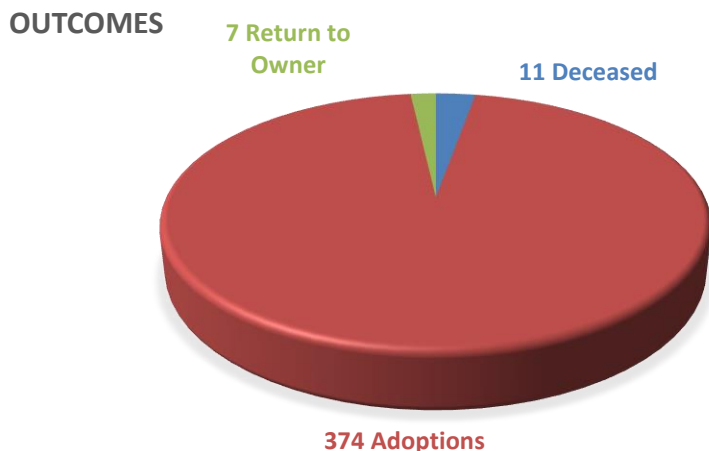
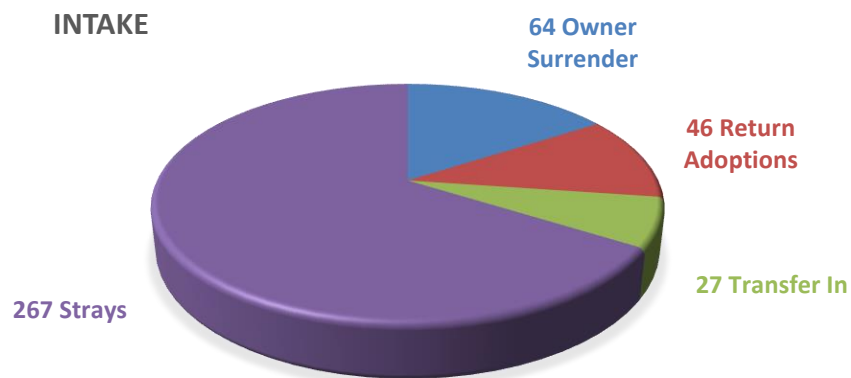

Intakes and Outcomes

Every year Fearless Kitty Rescue receives thousands of requests for help. We work tirelessly to offer resources or services for every request. In 2024 Fearless Kitty Rescue was able to take in 404 cats and kittens¹. This total intake number includes those who came from the public, municipal shelters, or other rescue organizations that are at capacity. With 374 adoptions in 2024, Fearless Kitty Rescue was able to find homes for 93% of those kitties we took in and some who were already with us from the previous year. Every year our goal to rescue more lives grows more important, but we cannot do it without your support!

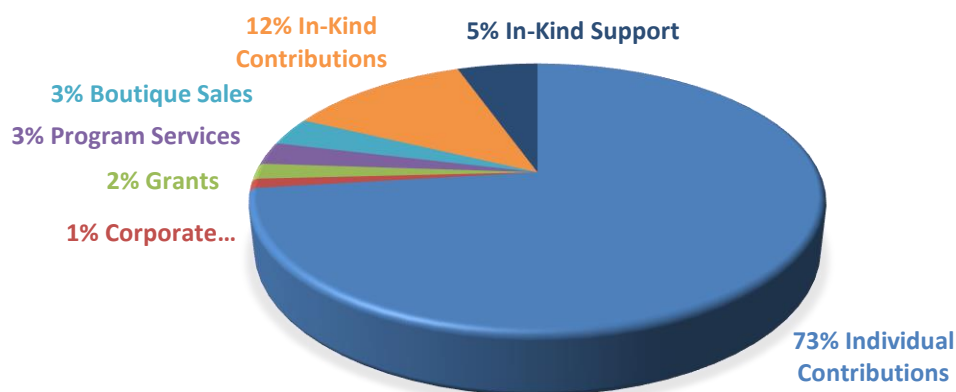

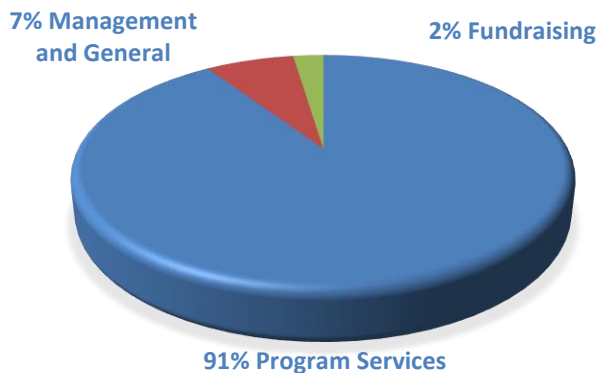
Donations and Earned Income
